The Property Committee met 2 times over the past year to discuss different matters, primarily the restoration of the altar side exterior wall. We extend our sincere gratitude to the Property Committee for their faithful service and diligent care of our church facilities. Their commitment to maintaining the building, addressing repairs promptly, and ensuring that our place of worship remains safe, welcoming, and well-kept has been a tremendous blessing to our parish. We are deeply thankful for their hard work, attention to detail, and the countless hours they have invested behind the scenes for the good of our community.

### **Clarkstown Property & Sub-Committee**

The Clarkstown Property (Tax Lot # 59.08-1-21), located at 660 Route 9W, Valley Cottage, NY, was purchased by our parish in 1987. The parcel type is still classified as Res Vacant Land and parcel dimensions are 7.7 acres. In 2025, we paid a total of \$4,382.20 in taxes on the property. We also paid a total of \$3,305.70 in charges/fees that was related to recording our easement on file with the Town of Clarkstown and performing an appraisal study on the property.

The Clarkstown Property sub-committee met 1 time during the year with the Executive Committee to discuss the appraisal study. Based on the appraisal study, the market value of the property is \$360,000.

On March 9, 2025 the General Body authorized the Executive Committee to explore the possibilities of selling the property and on November 23, 2025, the General Body decided to put the Clarkstown property on the market for sale for \$650,000. The property has since been listed on the market for sale.

# AUDITOR'S REPORT

Date: February 8, 2026

We have audited the accounts of St. Thomas Mar Thoma Church, NY, for the financial year ended December 31, 2025, in accordance with the Accounting and Auditing Guidelines revised by the General Body.

The audit was conducted to the best of our knowledge and ability. The following records and documents from 2025 were examined:

## Findings

- The financial records for 2025, including the Budget, Income & Expense Statements, and Balance Sheet, were well maintained, balanced, and found to be in order.
- The Individual Contribution List was reconciled with the Ledger and total income of \$387,122.47 was found to be accurate.
- Bank reconciliation statements were reviewed and found to be in order.

- Income and expense entries related to contra items were reviewed. The contra item for Outreach Program (GSF-Undesignated) Income is \$10,624.00; Expense is \$9,360.00 with a Difference: \$1,264.00
- There were 16 outstanding checks totaling \$13,432.23 at the end of 2025.
- Circular No. 153 dated March 14, 2025, regarding the Good Friday Collection, was issued on December 31, 2025.
- DC 365-2025 dated August 25, 2025, related to health insurance was in the amount of \$3,175.70. As the diocesan allocation is not applicable to New York State, the payable amount was \$2,474.37, which was paid on December 29, 2025.
- No major repairs were carried out during the year.

### **Recommendation**

1. We recommend that the Trustees should start the practice of presenting the Audited Receipts and payment Accounts for review to the Executive Committee as prescribed by the constitution in section 365. Current practice of sending the accounts for auditing after the committee review does not fulfill this clause, unless the accounts are once again reviewed by the Executive Committee after each quarterly audit.

### **Conclusion**

The accounts and correspondence records were found to be properly maintained and in good order. We sincerely thank the Vicar, Trustees, and Secretary for their diligent and secure maintenance of church records for the year 2025. We also thank the Vicar and the General Body of the church for entrusting us with the responsibility of auditing the accounts.
