I greet you all in the name of our Lord and savior Jesus Christ. Let's thank God for the month of full swing of spring and it's blessings. The pastel colors of early spring have turned bright, beautifying nature and asking us to transform our spiritual life into a vibrant spring season. Let me once again commend you for your prayerful participation in the 50 days of Lenten services, and a special thank you to all the homes that opened for prayer.
